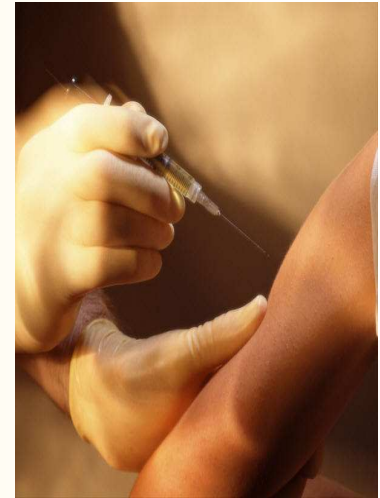

This year, [National Influenza Vaccination Week \(NIVW\)](#) is January 10 - January 16, 2010. NIVW was established to highlight the importance of continuing influenza vaccination, as well as fostering greater use of flu vaccine, after the holiday season. This year, NIVW will focus on H1N1 vaccine. Though this has been an unprecedented year in terms of the number of people who have received flu vaccinations, most people still have not gotten the 2009 H1N1 vaccine - there is still room for improvement among every age and risk group. One of the many goals for NIVW is to engage at-risk audiences who are not yet vaccinated, hesitant about vaccination, or unsure about where to get vaccinated.
